We are huge fans of feeding raw food, and have been feeding it since the late 1980's with great success and no negative experiences. Dogs were designed to eat raw food, and when on it have lean muscled bodies, bright eyes and shiny coats. For the most part, we have fed the raw diet exclusively over the years. Only recently have we started to split our diet between raw and dry food, feeding raw in the morning and the highest quality dry in the evening. We are still trying this mix out, and have not yet made any final determinations, but have noticed a slight improvement in coats by adding a high quality dry food once daily. As always, the diets we feed are free of chicken and grains. Darwin is our main raw food, and food highlighted in blue is also in rotation.
